Definition (description, specification, qualification)	<p><b>An approach or model</b> is an effort to translate policies into practice. An example of such a model is the Comprehensive Information and Orientation Programme (CIOP) that was developed through the Abu Dhabi Dialogue. This indicator considers any global, regional or national (including local) model or approach that support migrants' rights and that is developed and amended because of project interventions by SDC.</p> <p>Such models can also relate to decent work and labour market integration programmes of forcibly displaced persons. In this sense, labour rights of migrants related to <b>'migrants and forcibly displaced people' including all categories of people migrating.</b></p> <p>In order to be considered, an approach or model needs to be reported in an official document (meeting minutes, technical reports and official exchanges) and include recommendations for implementation.</p> <p><u>Calculation (see disaggregation):</u></p> <p>a+b+c</p>
